NEW SUBSTATION

The Parish Council has been advised that National Grid will be undertaking works to the Ash Tree which has a TPO – off Main Street. National Grid has exemption from needing to apply for undertaking works to TPO/Conservation Area trees, but in order to facilitate the delivery of a new substation there is a need for limited pruning of lower branches of TPO Ash tree to allow clearance for the vehicle and to avoid damage. The works are limited in scale and certainly beneficial for the tree to undertake in advance to avoid damage when the substation is brought in. It has been indicated that the works are to take place around the second week of September

www.westnorthants.gov.uk/bincollections alternatively you can download the West Northants App and set up a notification which reminds you at 4pm on a Thursday which bins are being collected.

As a reminder, all six Household Waste recycling centres in the county are open seven days a week from 10am to 4pm. **HOWEVER, AS FROM 3 NOVEMBER 2025 A BOOKING SYSTEM WAS INTRODUCED.** You can book a visit to the recycling centres by completing the online booking form, operational 24/7. If you cannot book online, you can make a booking through our customer service centre Monday to Friday from 9am to 5pm on **0300 126 7000**. Bookings are required for all Household Waste Recycling Centres. Bookings are site-specific and cannot be transferred. Bookings can be made up to two weeks ahead of your visit and up to 30 minutes before your visit – subject to availability.

NEVER BIN BATTERIES!

Domestic batteries can be put into a small plastic bag and tied to the handle of your wheeled bin for safe collection and recycling. Please put them on the following bins: Black lid general waste bin in Daventry

NB: the Council has seen a huge increase in vapes – the majority of which contain lithium-ion batteries – being thrown into household waste. Instead, residents can recycle small electrical items, including vapes, from home – same procedure as batteries.

FIX MY STREET (FORMALLY STREET DOCTOR)

All villagers are reminded that any problems with potholes, overgrown verges, restricted visibility at road junctions, empty salt bin etc can be reported directly to Fix My Street – WNC would prefer contact to be made online and have advised that “If the problem is categorised as an emergency, then the phone number will appear for people to ring instead.” **In addition, any problems with overgrown public footpaths etc should be reported in the same manner.** It is also helpful to take a photograph of the problem as this can be uploaded when reporting the problem. Any repairs and all practical work required must be reported via www.Fixmystreet.northamptonshire.gov.uk – this can be done anonymously if you prefer.

Problems with the streetlights however, must be reported to the Clerk as these need to be directed to E.on.

SMALL ELECTRICAL GOODS – COLLECTION SERVICE

Small electrical items that have a plug or are battery powered can be recycled. Place the item in a standard sized carrier bag and simply place on the lid of your black rubbish bin on your normal collection week. PLEASE DO NOT PLACE INSIDE THE BIN. The electrical items will be taken to a special facility where they will be safely dismantled & recycled. YES TO: small kitchen appliances, curlers, straighteners, hairdryers, kettle, toasters, irons, digital clocks & watches, clippers, shavers, smoke detectors & thermostats, mobile phones & electrical gadgets, consoles & remotes, audio devices, radios & MP3 players and power tools. NO TO: large electrical items or car batteries.

S247 Town & Country Planning Act 1990 – the stopping up and diversion of a length of CT2 at Hannington in West Northamptonshire.

2026/2670/FULL – conversion & extension of existing domestic outbuilding to create a new 3-bedroom dwelling. Manir Farm, Bridle Road, Hannington. Approved by WNC 4 Sept 2026.

2026/2026/FULL - proposed use of land as open storage yard (use Class B8). Land south of Woodmeadow, Kettering Road, Hannington.

S119 Public Path Diversion Order 2019 – Public Bridleway CT8 (Part).
